4 Day Clinic Schedule

1st Day Thursday

- 1pm 5:30pm Evaluations: Be ready at your scheduled time, your horse should be warmed up and ready to make a barrel run at your current competition speed. 4 riders every 30 minutes, this is the time Charmayne uses to evaluate you and your horse and where you specifically need work. Dustin Cooksey (Equine Chiropractor) will be available to check your horse during this time, if you desire. Charmayne would like the Master Certified Equine Dentist to look at your horse's teeth at this time. If you want him to work on your horse's teeth, please check with Charmayne's assistant.
- 5:30pm (time approximate): Demonstration with Charmayne in the arena. (You do not need your horse for this portion of the clinic).
- 6:30pm: Dental Presentation Master Certified Equine Dentist

2nd Day Friday (Times Approximate)

- 8am 12:30pm: Drills; Working on Rate, Angles to Barrels, Spacing from Barrel, Working on Hands, Seat and Legs. And Axis Points (2 barrel or line drill). Everyone on their horses in the arena and warmed up. Bring longer or split reins for this portion of the clinic
- 12:30pm -1:30pm: Lunch; Note, schedule times will vary slightly
- 1:30pm: Barrel Pattern work. Split into 2 Groups for afternoon based on students or horses that need a break and horses that might be going for dentistry.
- 1:30pm 3:30pm: Group 1 with Charmayne and assistants on the Barrel Pattern
- 3:30pm 5:30pm: Group 2 with Charmayne and assistants on the Barrel Pattern

3rd Day Saturday (Times Approximate)
